The Student Integrity Board aims to fulfill the following objectives:

- Hear alleged violations of the GGC Student Code of Conduct via the formal resolution process as a hearing panel;
- Educate the Georgia Gwinnett College community about the Student Code of Conduct and students' rights and responsibilities;
- Serve as a role model to the Georgia Gwinnett College community.

Once selected, students are required to attend all training sessions and be available for scheduled hearings and other programs/ events. This is a position for **responsible** and **highly motivated** students.

All applicants must be currently enrolled students in good standing with the College, possess a minimum 2.5 grade point average at the time of application, and must be in good standing with the Office of Student Integrity (i.e. cannot be on conduct probation).

All completed applications must be submitted in person to the Office of Student Integrity, Student Center Suite #2150/

Interviews will be conducted in April. You will be contacted via phone if selected for an interview. Decision letters detailing selection status will be sent out as soon as possible following interviews. Service on the Student Integrity Board will begin in fall of the next academic year.
